

## **The Water Works and Sewer Board of the City of Eufaula** **2020 Accomplishments**

Produced 604 million gallons of potable water for use by our community.

Treated 546 million gallons of wastewater and returned it to the environment safely.

Maintained Daily service to 5200 water and 4200 sanitary sewer connections.

Completed over 9,191 work orders for services and repairs (177/wk).

Completed over 352 after hour calls for service.

Processed over 537,000 water, sewer and garbage billing transactions (10,337/wk).

Completed fiscal year 2020 with surplus revenue and received a comment free audit.

Continued Construction of 2017 Bond Projects including Wastewater Treatment Plant Influent Pumping Station Replacement, Lift Station Rehabilitation Phase II and Sanitary Sewer Collection System Phase II.

Completed Visual Inspection of all 11 Water Supply Tanks and washout of Tanks #5 and #11 and rehab of Tanks 2 and 3.

Tested and Flushed 320 Fire Hydrants.

Completed and Distributed 2019 Consumer Confidence Reports to all customers.

Conducted Preliminary Assessment of 10-year Capital Improvements Plan Projects to be undertaken in the next several years.

Issued Series 2020-A (Non-Taxable) and Series 2020-B (Taxable) Water and Sewer Revenue Bonds in the amount of \$11.82 million to fund identified Capital Improvements.

Received tentative grant funding approval from Economic Development Agency of \$1.94 million to complete \$3.5 million in upgrades to WWTP, Barbour Creek Outfall Sanitary Sewer Line and Sanitary Sewer Lines in the Eufaula Industrial Park.

Instituted COVID-19 response, including additional cleaning, temperature screenings for all employees and visitors, and increased PPE use.

Purchased two new vehicles.

Cleared 13 sections of Water/Sewer Easements.

Received National Pollution Discharge Elimination Systems Permit Renewal for our Wastewater Treatment Plant from ADEM/EPA.

Worked with numerous Industrial, Commercial and Residential developers regarding proposed expansion of existing facilities and installation of new facilities.

Obtained Federal Legislative Authorization to procure the 56+ acre site of our Wastewater Treatment Facility from the Secretary of the Army.

Hosted numerous Federal, State and City primary, runoff and general elections as a polling place precinct.
